3. Gautrain

Gautrain is an 80-kilometre (50-mile) higher-speed express commuter rail system in Gauteng, South Africa, which links Johannesburg, Pretoria, Kempton Park and O. R. Tambo International Airport.


To travel to Irene Country Lodge from O.R. Tambo, take the Gautrain (station is in O. R Tambo), the East/West line - ride 2 stops to Marlboro, transfer to North/South lane (1 minute walk – platforms are opposite one another) ride 2 stops, arrive at Centurion Gautrain station. Take a taxi from Gautrain station's car park. There are friendly staff that will assist you or organize a shuttle service with Irene Country Lodge (from Centurion Gautrain Station to Irene Country Lodge is 5 km).

DIRECTIONS FROM OR TAMBO AIRPORT (off-peak periods):

Please note that Nellmapius Drive gets extremely busy most of the day. It is advisable to use the alternative route mentioned below:

- Take the R21 from OR TAMBO Airport towards Pretoria.
- Take the M31 off-ramp onto Nellmapius Drive, Irene.
- At the stop sign, turn left onto Nellmapius Drive.
- Continue on Nellmapius Drive, passing under a bridge until you reach a 4-way Stop.
- Continue straight, cross the next stop sign and head towards a roundabout. Irene Dairy will be on your left-hand
- Continue straight until you reach the third roundabout; Irene Country Lodge is on your right.

DIRECTIONS FROM OR TAMBO AIRPORT (peak periods):

- Take the R21 from OR TAMBO Airport towards Pretoria.
- Take the Ben Schoeman Highway (N1) split road to your left towards Johannesburg.
- Take the second off-ramp, John Vorster Drive.
- At the end of the off-ramp, turn right.
- Continue with John Vorster Drive, crossing 4 traffic lights towards Irene.
- At the 5th traffic light, turn left. There will be a golf course on the left-hand side.
- Irene Country Lodge is situated approximately 900m on the left-hand side next to the roundabout.

DIRECTIONS FROM JOHANNESBURG:

- Take the Ben Schoeman Highway (N1) from Johannesburg towards Pretoria.
- Take the Pietersburg Highway split.
- Take the first off-ramp, John Vorster Drive.
- At the end of the off-ramp, turn right.
- Continue with John Vorster Drive, crossing 4 traffic lights towards Irene.
- At the 5th traffic light, turn left. There will be a golf course on the left-hand side.
- Irene Country Lodge is situated approximately 900m on the left-hand side next to the roundabout.

It's important to remember that South Africa's requirements for entry differ from country to country and can change at any time.

Allow sufficient time to obtain your visa, as there can be delays in the application.

Currency: South African Rand (ZAR). Always ensure you have cash on you as some smaller shops won't accept cards, plus you'll need it for tips.

Time Zone: South African Standard Time (GMT+2)

Emergency numbers: 112 (for any emergency from a cell phone), 10111 (for police response only), 10177 (for ambulance response only)

Official language: South Africa has 11: Afrikaans, English, Ndebele, Northern Sotho, Sotho, SiSwati, Tsonga, Tswana, Venda, Xhosa, and Zulu!

Taxis in South Africa: You can use Uber in South Africa if you have the App. Taxis are pretty cheap, but make sure you use a metered taxi or agree on a price before you get in the taxi.

Health requirements for entry to South Africa: yellow fever vaccination certificate (only for travellers coming from certain African and Latin American countries), comprehensive travel insurance (recommended). Other vaccinations and medications may be recommended depending on the areas you plan to visit, so make sure to make an appointment with your local GP or travel clinic before you go. Malaria tablets are normally recommended if you visit Kruger National Park.

What type of plug does South Africa use?



The type N socket and plug are the official standard in South Africa. Type C plugs are also official, but not type C sockets. However, this does not pose a problem since type C plugs are 100% compatible with type N sockets. The older type M standard is being phased out but is still ubiquitous.

Weather South Africa enjoys a temperate and pleasant climate, with warm sunny days most of the year. The southern hemisphere's seasons are opposite to those in the northern hemisphere, so our Summer runs from November to February, when most of the country is characterised by warm to hot weather.
